The City of Mount Gambier seeks written Expressions of Interest from suitable operators for the following opportunity:

CENTENARY TOWER - CARETAKER

The right to operate the Centenary Tower as Caretaker under Licence from Council.

The Caretaker role would be ideal for a person(s) with an interest in tourism and the promotion of Mount Gambier and its environment.

The Caretaker is responsible to attend at the Tower during periods when it is likely that visitors, tourists and education groups would wish to access the Tower, including weekends, public and school holidays (SA & Vic).

The Caretaker is also responsible for the day to day maintenance of the Tower and its immediate surrounds in a clean and tidy condition.

Council seeks to grant a Licence to a suitable operator who is:

- able to attend the Tower on a regular basis
- knowledgeable and conversant on the features of Mount Gambier, the Crater Lakes and surrounds
- a good communicator with excellent person skills
- committed to and prepared to work with local and regional tourism operators and Council's Visitor Information Centre in the promotion of local/regional tourism.

Potential applicants are advised that the Caretaker is not an employment or volunteer position, and the successful Licensee will be responsible for their own transport, insurances and other arrangements.

A nominal retainer will be negotiated with the successful applicant and this may be supplemented by Tower entry fees and sale of merchandise.

Submissions that demonstrate a commitment to working with other local and regional tourism operators and Council's Visitor Information Centre in the promotion of local/regional tourism will be highly regarded.
